Report of Editors' Meeting, 18 February 2009

The editorial team of ISO/IEC TR 24772 met at 10:00 am on 18 February 2009 via web/telecon using facilities provided by Jim Moore. Attendees were:

The primary intended purpose of the meeting was to discuss submissions for new material proposed for inclusion in a future draft of the technical report. Available materials were reviewed. Some editing was performed “on the fly.” Some items were assigned to individuals in the editorial team for further rewrite. Following completion of the rewrites, the editorial team will issue a report containing its recommendations for actions by the working group.

The items considered and additional details regarding their consideration are provided below:

HJW

Clive had revised the description in accordance with the suggestions of the previous telecon. The revision was considered at this telecon. The name of the description was changed to “Unanticipated Exceptions from Library Routines” and minor suggestions for improvement were made. Clive will revise the description again and submit the results for consideration by WG23.

KLK

The prior telecon had assigned DTK to Jim Moore for a rewrite and had decided to change the three-letter-code. Jim’s new draft, KLK, was considered at this telecon. Jim’s draft was accepted with the addition of one cross-reference. It will be submitted to WG23 for consideration.

LRM

In the previous telecon, the draft of PUS was considered suitable but it was decided to change the code to LRM. This was implemented. It will be submitted to WG23 for consideration.

NSQ

Following the recommendations of the previous telecon, John had revised it with the goal of differentiating it from other vulnerability descriptions considering mismatched signatures. The telecon reviewed it, suggesting some additional minor changes, which John will address. The result will be submitted to WG23 for consideration.
